Information Management: Evidence and Case Tracking

Baseline Objectives

- Tracking: The monitoring and accounting of SAKs through the course, or path, of their movement from collection through final disposition.
- Reporting: The task of delivering a written, detailed report to the appropriate entity within the prescribed time period and with the applicable data provided.
- **Inventory:** A detailed and descriptive list of articles or items (for purposes of this solicitation, SAKs) containing information such as, but not limited to: item identifiers, quantity, and location of the item.

Deliverables

- Establish evidence tracking, case management, and victim notification mechanisms
- Enhance the jurisdiction's ability to manage and monitor the progress of kits through the evidence collection and testing process,
- Enhanced case management capabilities that assist in case assignment, tiered supervisory review, and electronic case tracking
- Provide victims with access to information about their cases.






