Lessons Learned

- Make the audit a requirement (you will need the data later in the process)
- Develop a collaborative team with everyone involved and meeting together
- Develop and work with a software team; IT support is critical (the right IT support)
- Dedicate a full-time person to the tracking software and LE, PA, Medical follow-ups
- Control Kit intake (keeps better track of inventory, minimize cost/purchasing)
- Find a “sweet spot” to mandate for LE to have the kits/reference samples to the lab (30-60 days)
- Consider legislation requiring participation for LE, PA, and Medical participation*
- Have a plan to deal with older kits (serialize, populate old information in software)

Development

- IT resources needed to develop and maintain
- Lab Involvement
- Collaborative Involvement
- Privacy Issues
- No login for victims (internet access)
- Hacking
- SIMPLE USER INTERFACE
- Declination forms (decide if LE should provide or provide in kits)
- What victim/survivor notification is required by law?



Implementation

- Training (In-person, live webinars, and archive YouTube videos)
- Value of a full-time person to run the show
- Value of face time at the agencies
- Value of accurate survey/audit data from agencies (with case numbers)
- Gathering agency contacts has been very useful (make it part of survey)
- LOTS of follow-up and verification is needed

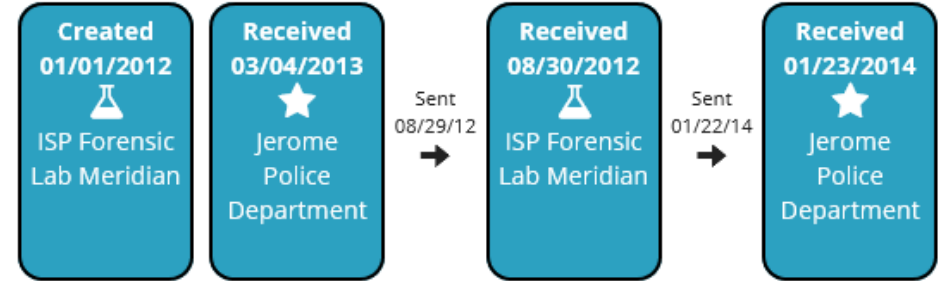
